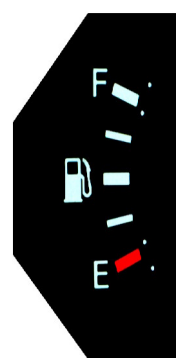

Fuel Surcharge Road Transport

Although the oil prices for the last week have gone up by nearly 10%, we still see falling fuel prices for road related transport also for the next period. Valid from from 01st of April, the fuel surcharge for International Road Transport will be adjusted down from 12,3% to 11,5%. For domestic road transport the fuel surcharge will be adjusted down from 6,7% to 6,4%.

There is still a turbulence in the currency market. However the last month EUR has strengthen it`s possision against NOK and currencies like SEK and DK.

With effect from 1st of April our Currency Adjustment Factor for international overland shipments will be adjusted as follows:

Europe and Irland	Up from 7,1 % to 7,6 %
Scandinavia (ex. Norway)	down from 5,1 % to 4,5 %
United Kingdom	no CAF for UK at the moment
